

Government organization affiliated to the InterDom program seeks students of international relations, diplomacy, law or related areas, to become involved in projects related to the enhancement of the bilateral relations between the Dominican Republic and Haiti.

The intern will have the opportunity to participate in a program that aims to contribute to the strengthening and the development of opportunities that will allow for greater exchange and cooperation between the two countries. The intern will become familiar with the operations of the organization through an orientation program.

Under the supervision and guidance of management, the intern is expected to contribute to the establishment of a working agenda to facilitate bilateral dialogue, the prevention of conflict, and the management of risk and disaster. The ideal candidate must show interest in interacting with high-level diplomatic authorities in order to align him/herself with the corporate development strategy of the nation. The internship offers the opportunity to work between 22 to 25 hours per week.

All applicants are required to have completed at least 6-college level Spanish courses or demonstrate equivalent skills, have basic computer skills and knowledge of the Microsoft Office package.

The internship offers the intern the opportunity to test his/her leadership and communication skills and to strengthen his/her knowledge of international relations. Finally, the intern will acquire a broader view of the bilateral relations between the Dominican Republic and the Republic of Haiti, will establish new business relationships and gain experience in the diplomatic arena, which will add value to his/her resume.
