

Nonprofit organization affiliated to the InteRDom program seeks student of international relations to perform an internship on the implementation of a public awareness programs.

The intern will have the opportunity to participate in a program that aims to build interest in international relations among young Dominican professionals. The intern will become familiar with the operations of the organization through an orientation program.

Under the supervision and guidance of management, the intern is expected to contribute to the establishment of a working agenda to meet the objectives of the internship. The ideal candidate must show interest in interacting with high-level diplomatic authorities in order to align him/herself with the corporate development strategy of the nation. The internship offers the opportunity to work between 22 to 25 hours per week.

All applicants are required to have basic computer skills and knowledge of the Microsoft Office package. The Intern is required to possess an advanced level of Spanish and English; other languages will be valued.
