## It is all about location!

InterDom offers modern and comfortable student residences with wireless Internet strategically located in a central downtown neighborhood of Santo Domingo. The residences are close to some of the most important cultural centers of the city, and just 10 minutes from the historic Colonial Zone.

They are a short walk from multiple public transportation routes in a major student a commercial district. Nearby are 3 university campuses and many restaurants, banks and shops, and minutes away from the historic and cultural zones, public transportation, restaurants and shopping...



## Feeling at home...

Most InterDom interns are lodged in apartments administered and maintained by FUNGLODE/GFDD and located steps from the Foundation. These apartments provide students with a private bedroom and bathroom and a spacious shared living area and kitchen. All rooms are equipped with ceiling fans for comfort.

The residences are designed so that interns can take advantage of the opportunity to make friends with other interns from all parts of the world, exchange ideas and share points of view, all the while maintaining a sense of privacy and cooking to your taste!

**It is our hope that you will find the available housing option comfortable, convenient, and conducive to your academic and professional success.**

### InterDom PROVIDES:

- Bed linens, pillows and a duvet
- Towels
- Mops and cleaning brushes and clothes
- Sponges and soap to wash dishes
- Trash bags
- Insecticide (for roaches and ants)
- Ironing board and iron
- Laundry facilities
- Empty refillable water bottle (botellón)
- Coffee and seasonal fruits (upon arrival only)

## Amenities

**Bathrooms:** Most of the rooms have a private bathroom. InterDom provides a set of towels and soap.

**Kitchen:** The kitchen is furnished with the appliances, cookware and silverware necessary for basic cooking needs. Upon arrival, interns are also provided with a large jug of clean drinking water as well as some basic food items.

**Television and Wireless Internet:** Interns have access to FUNGLODE's main high-speed wireless network, as well as IT technicians to help resolve any computer and connection issues. All apartments are furnished with a television to view local channels. Telephone service is not available. The InterDom PRE-DEPARTURE Guide gives options of cell phone services to keep in touch with friends and family.

**Laundry:** Laundry facilities are provided in all apartments at no additional charge.

**Security:** Apartments have a 24-hour security guard stationed at the entrance to the building. Interns are also provided with keys both to the apartment and to their individual bedroom.

**Policies:** The student residences are private independent-living facilities, but are subject to policies regulating conduct and visitation as deemed necessary by the administration. Prior to move-in, interns sign a housing contract with InterDom in which these policies are outlined.

### Interns are expected to purchase:

- Food
- Paper towels, toilet paper and toiletries (toothbrush, shampoo, toothpaste, etc.)
- Laundry detergent
