Project Profile:	The teaching assistants support the head teachers in the planning and implementation of learning experiences that enhance the intellectual, emotional, social and physical development of the children in a safe and healthy learning environment.
Objectives of the Internship:	 Provide mentoring and support to individual children or to small groups to help them comply with the teachers' assignments and to reinforce the learning concepts presented by the teachers. Provide support to individual students inside and outside the classroom so that they may fully participate in the activities. Organize and supervise games and other recreational activities in order to promote physical, mental and social development. Plan, prepare, and develop various teaching materials such as bibliographies, charts and graphs. Will work with some children who have learning difficulties, and who are being assisted by the areas of psychology and counseling. Provide support to students with emotional or behavioral problems and help them develop their social skills. Teach classes according to the curriculum and under the guidance of the head teacher. Study and thoroughly learn about the proposed curriculum for the grade level that is assigned to him/her. Provide support to the planning of classes, according to the academic curriculum of each grade level. Formulate the planning for the groups with which s/he works. Evaluate, together with the teacher, the students' learning process. Ready the classrooms for classes. Attend the team and staff meetings. Collaborate with the head teachers in carrying out special events or extracurricular activities. Assist in the development of educational materials and in the follow up of the work progress in notebooks and books. The Intern may be required to perform other related tasks.
