

Teaching Assistant - Special Education

Project Profile: The teaching assistants support the head teachers in the planning and implementation of learning experiences that enhance the intellectual, emotional, social and physical development of the children in a safe and healthy learning environment.

Objectives of the Internship:

- Provide assistance to children with special needs, both physical and mental.
- Provide support to individual students inside and outside the classroom so that they may fully participate in the activities.
- Organize and supervise games and other recreational activities in order to promote physical, mental and social development.
- Observe, understand and analyze the behavior of each student.
- Provide support to students with emotional or behavioral problems and help them develop their social skills.
- Teach classes according to the curriculum and under the guidance of the head teacher.
- Collaborate with the record-keeping of each student's progress.
- Attend the team and staff meetings.
- Collaborate with the head teachers in carrying out special events or extracurricular activities.
- The Intern may be required to perform other related tasks.

Requirements:

- Students in the areas of education, psychology and special education.
- Spanish must be the first language.
- Ability to adapt to multicultural environments.
- Good communication skills, oral and written.
- Ability to work in a team.
- Previous experience in the area will be considered.

Opportunities:

- Gain professional experience in their area of study.
- Become familiar with the teaching methods used in the Dominican Republic.
- Learn teaching strategies.
- Develop leadership, creativity and innovation skills.
